Vancouver School District - Support Staff Recognition Scholarship (2018/2019)

In recognition of the work of staff who hold a support role in our schools, and the positive impact they have on students, the Vancouver School District created a new student scholarship. In honour of all the support staff across the District, two scholarships in the amount of \$2,500 will be awarded to students at the end of the school year (June 2019). The Support Staff Recognition Scholarship will recognize graduating Vancouver School District students who have made a positive contribution to their school communities. These students have demonstrated strong school involvement, maintained a good academic record, demonstrated a strong work ethic and perseverance, and intend to enroll in post-secondary education at a recognized program, institution, college, or university.

Students wishing to apply for this scholarship need to complete a written statement (500 words maximum) that expresses the impact a support staff worker has made on their education.

Criteria for applying for the VSB Support Staff Recognition Scholarship:

- 1. Complete attached application form
- 2. Complete graduation requirements by August 31, 2019
- 3. Write a written statement that expresses the impact a support worker has made on your education
- Submit completed applications to your school's Graduation Scholarship Committee; the school scholarship committee will select one student's application to submit to the District's selection committee
- 5. Submit completed applications to your school's scholarship committee by May 10, 2019; the school's scholarship committee will select one student's application to submit to the district's selection committee.
